COMMUNITY PRIDE RECOGNITION PROGRAM

Well-maintained homes, businesses and landscaping in a community are positive attributes that should be encouraged. The City of Whitehall's Community Pride Recognition program recognizes and encourages beautification efforts. Through this program, the Whitehall City Council will honor residents, businesses and local organizations that have enhanced the visual appeal of the community.

Overall General Appearance

- Exhibits pride in residence, business, or local organization in exterior upkeep and maintenance
- Maintenance of planting areas and all visible yard
- Absence of debris
- Native plant species are encouraged

Entries will not be selected solely on lavish architecture or professional landscaping. Instead, they will be recognized on the pride and creativity exhibited, as well as "street appeal," i.e., what can be seen walking or driving by.

Entrants can be nominated by property owners, neighboring residents or other interested parties. You MAY also nominate yourself.

- Nominations must be received by August 15
- Nominees must reside or be located within the Whitehall city limits
- The Community Pride committee will visit each nominated site

Award winners will be listed on the City's website and in the newsletter. They will also be honored at a City Council meeting and receive a Certificate of Award for their efforts.

The mission of the City of Whitehall Community Pride Community is to develop and implement a program to acknowledge general maintenance and upkeep of residences, businesses, and local organizations.
